Lawn Maintenance-fall back to green

Now that the weather is cooling and water restrictions have been lifted, the Summerfield Archicectural Committee is enforcing our CC&Rs and Architectural Standards. (See *summerfieldhoa.net* for a copy of our policies). Three simple things you can do to keep your lawn green:

- Adequate irrigation—early in the morning to help wash away destructive rabbit waste
- Fertilize—apply before a rain; do it yourself or hire a lawncare company
- **Aerate**—typically recommended for twice a year
